This petition for naturalization, heretofore filed, respectfully shows:

(1) My full, true, and correct name is ANGELINA GUALTIERI

 (4) I was born on March 8, 1889, in Alife, Italy

 (6) I am a widow married; the name of my husband is Giuseppe Gualtieri, we were married on March 18, 1943, at Pittsburg, Pa. he was born at Calabria, Italy, on March 19, 1889 and entered the United States at New York, New York on Unknown for permanent residence in the United States and now resides at Deceased and was naturalized on Feb. 13, 1925 at Mt. Clemens, Michigan certificate No. 528 or became a citizen by

(14) I am able to read, write and speak the English language (unless exempted therefrom). (15) I am, and have been during all the periods required by law, a person of good moral character, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the United States. I am willing, if required by law, to bear arms on behalf of the United States, to perform noncombatant service in the Armed Forces of the United States, and to perform work of national importance under civilian direction (unless exempted therefrom). continuously in the United States since March 7, 1905 and continuously in the State in which this petition is made for the term of 6 months at least immediately preceding the date of this petition and I have been physically present in the United States for at least one-half of the five year period immediately preceding the date of this petition. (17) I have not heretofore made petition for naturalization No. on at in the Court, and such petition was denied by that Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit:

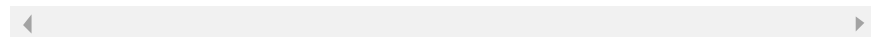
